

### The 2024 Philadelphia Show: Antiques, Art & Design







Join us for the 62<sup>nd</sup> annual Philadelphia Show on the East Terrace of the Philadelphia Museum of Art April 26 – 28, 2024. An esteemed group of approximately 40 U.S. dealers and galleries will present exceptional pieces of fine art, silver, decorative arts and furniture, ceramics, and jewelry. Leading the 2024 Show are Chair Amy Fox, Vice Chair Ellen Simon, and Honorary Chair Anne Hamilton.

Programming will begin in early 2024 with lectures and conversations featuring artists, curators, dealers, and more. An intimate Kickoff Party will be held on April 9 in the home of a museum Trustee for all corporate and individual supporters followed by the Preview Party on April 25. Cocktails and hors d'oeuvres will be enjoyed by the nearly 600 attendees as they get a sneak peek of the Show before its public opening. April 26-28 will feature general admission access, in-booth lectures and conversations, and family activities.
